A 5-character string is stored in memory location with label 'dat1'. Write an ALP that will insert spaces between the characters and store the modified string in memory location with label 'dat2'.

For e.g. if the contents of dat1 is as follows

loc1: hello

after the ALP is executed dat2 should be as follows

loc2:h e l l o

The ASCII equivalent of space is 20_{H} .
